Jorge Azcarate with CEA Group concurred with staff's comments except for comments made from the Parks Department on item 1 recommending for all areas shown within the "100' Wide Existing Gas Easement" to remain undisturbed.

Liza Ramirez with Parks & Recreation Department noted that Richard Garcia is out of town and he is the staff person who reviews and approves the designs for parks.

Kimberly Forsyth, Lead Planner, noted that this item is on the agenda as a preliminary plat and that park's comments can be addressed at a later date when the final plat is reviewed and presented.

Commissioner Brandrup suggested the applicant figure out a way of putting in some logical means to stabilize the 100' wide existing gas easement through some method that still allows trucks to pass through but without causing much disturbance to the easement.

Commissioner Nance asked if there was anyone in the public who wished to speak in favor or against this request. There was no response.

ACTION: Motion made by Commissioner Wright, seconded by Commissioner De La Cruz, and unanimously carried to **APPROVE SUSU12-00111 WITH THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE APPLICANT COORDINATE WITH THE PARKS DEPARTMENT DURING THE FINAL PLAT SUBMITTAL AND APPROVE ALL STATED MODIFICATIONS AND THE TWO CONDITIONS:**

1. THAT THE CITY PLAN COMMISSION REQUIRE LANDSCAPE AT THE REAR OF DOUBLE FRONTAGE LOTS ON GREG MARTINEZ;
2. AND THAT THE ANNEXATION OF CHERRINGTON STREET IS REQUIRED PRIOR TO FINAL PLAT APPROVAL.

(SUAX12-00002.**

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8. Discussion and Action on the 2012 Updated Parks and Recreation Master Plan

Marci Tuck, Open Space Trails and Parks Coordinator, gave a brief power point presentation and noted that at the December 13th, 2012 meeting she went over some of the highlights of the Parks and Recreation Master Plan updates, basically highlighting Chapters 3 and 9. At a previous meeting the Commission had asked Ms. Tuck to come back for the rational nexis between the bond projects that were approved and the Master Plan. She presented the Bond Projects and the Master Plan and answered questions from the Commission.

ACTION: Motion made by Commissioner Wright, seconded by Commissioner Reveles, and unanimously carried to **APPROVE THE 2012 UPDATED PARKS AND RECREATION MASTER PLAN.**

Liza Tobias-Ramirez with the Parks and Recreation Department gave a brief power point presentation and noted that this item will be presented to the Parks Advisory Board on January 14, 2013 and then to City Council. She noted that they have not received any negative comments and also noted that she is here to receive advice from the Commission on how to proceed. She answered questions from the Commission.

The Commission requested that a pedestrian connection between the neighborhood to the north and El Paso High School be considered and to continue the negotiations for the renewal of the lease.

Commissioner Nance asked if there was anyone in the public who wished to speak in favor or against this request. There was no response.

ACTION: Motion made by Commissioner Brandrup, seconded by Commissioner Wright, and unanimously carried to **RECOMMEND A CONNECTION BETWEEN THE NEIGHBORHOOD TO THE NORTH AND EL PASO HIGH SCHOOL BE CONSIDERED, AND TO CONTINUE NEGOTIATIONS FOR THE RENEWAL OF THE LEASE.**
