Kimberly Forsyth, Lead Planner, noted that as part of the annexation agreement, the applicant is required to dedicate the triangular portion at the northeast part of their land for the future connection of Pebble Hills to Zaragoza and are also required to contribute approximately \$33,000 to the future construction of the intersection.

Bradley Roe with Roe Engineering concurred with staff's comments except for the zoning.

Kimberly Forsyth, Lead Planner, gave a brief power point presentation and gave a brief summary of Title 19 (19.21.101.C) Exceptions for sidewalks. Staff has recommended to Council to delete three of the exceptions that currently exist and Council agreed. Council also modified another exception.

Commissioner Wright suggested that items 8 and 9 are not exceptions.

Commissioner Nance requested that under item 9, the word **generally** be removed.
