Carlos Gallinar gave a powerpoint presentation updating on the comprehensive plan based on the goals and accomplishments to date. He noted that Plan El Paso has received state and national recognition. El Paso has the largest concentration of CNUAs accredited in the country and that includes not only the public sector but also some in the private sector. He noted that the City of El Paso is the first to have a comprehensive plan in the state of Texas and the second in the country.

Commissioner Ardivino asked if there has been any consideration for increased security in the downtown revitalization. Mr. Gallinar will follow up with the Police Department and bring that information back to the commission. The commission asked if the downtown traffic signal synchronization is being expanded throughout the major arterials throughout the city. Mr. Gallinar will check with the Engineering Department and bring that information back to the commission as well.

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The commission agreed to hear the Addition to the Agenda prior to hearing item 16.

This will add Chapter 20.10.146 Civic and Cultural District to supplemental use regulations. This establishes the district and states its purpose. The second part identifies the district boundary.

Karla Nieman, Assistant City Attorney, clarified how signs are permitted.
