NOTICE OF RUNOFF ELECTION – CITY OF EL PASO**

**RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A RUNOFF ELECTION ON
JUNE 15, 2013 FROM THE 2013 GENERAL ELECTION IN THE
CITY OF EL PASO FOR THE ELECTION OF OFFICERS.**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

1. On Saturday, June 15, 2013, a runoff election will be held by the City of El Paso, at El Paso, Texas, for the purpose of electing the following named officers of the City of El Paso:

Mayor
District Representative No. 2
District Representative No. 4
District Representative No. 7

2. The election shall be held at the polling places designated in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes, and said polling places shall open at 7 a.m. and remain open until 7 p.m. on the day of the election.

3. The City Clerk of the City of El Paso shall be the Clerk for early voting for said election and the County Elections Administrator, Mr. Javier Chacon, is appointed as the Deputy Clerk for early voting. His address is:

The County Courthouse is hereby designated as the early voting station for such election. In addition, the following branch offices for early voting on the days determined by the County Elections Department by personal appearance shall be authorized for such election, and/or any locations that might be added or changed by the County Elections Department, and hours for early voting by personal appearance shall be authorized for such election:

(Early voting shall be held weekdays from Monday, June 3, 2013, through Tuesday, June 11, 2013. There is NO voting Sunday, June 9, 2013. The hours for early voting at each early voting location are as noted below.)

In addition, mobile voting stations shall also be authorized and used for early voting at publicly owned buildings in the City as set forth in Exhibit “B.” The City Clerk is authorized to make any corrections or revisions regarding the early voting locations, and the dates and times for such voting, as recommended by the El Paso County Elections Administrator.

4. The special canvassing board and election officials appointed for the May 11, 2013 general election shall be reappointed for the runoff election and the Municipal Clerk is authorized to approve of any necessary personnel changes upon receipt of notice from the County Elections Administrator.

5. Voting of the Election, and early voting therefore, shall be by the use of lawfully approved voting systems and ballots.

6. Such election shall be held in the manner and form prescribed by the laws of the State of Texas. The qualified voters who reside in the City of El Paso who reside in Representative District No. 2, No. 4, and No. 7 shall vote for the Representative in their respective district.

7. By approving and signing this resolution, the Mayor officially confirms as his action all matters recited herein which by law come within his jurisdiction.

8. A substantial copy hereof shall serve as notice of said election.

9. The City Clerk shall give notice of such election by posting a copy of such notice in English and Spanish in the Office of the City Clerk and by publishing a copy of said notice in both English and Spanish in a newspaper of the City as required by law.

10. The City Clerk shall deliver notice of this election to the county clerk and voter registrar of El Paso County, as required by law.
