
O P I N I O N

This Court has reviewed Appellant's points of error, and determined that same are without merit, and therefore overrules them.

In doing so, this Court specifically overrules Appellant's point of error stating that the complaint in the instant offense was defective because it failed to allege a culpable mental state. This Court holds that a complaint for a red light violation is in the nature of a strict liability offense, and a mental culpable state need not be alleged nor proven. Brune v. State, 83-MCA-259 (Mun.Ct. App. - 1984).

The Judgment of the Trial Court is affirmed.


