OPINION

Appellant appeals his conviction in Municipal Court for a violation alleging he operated his vehicle at a speed of 51 miles per hour in a 35 mile per hour zone. Appellant was found guilty and assessed a fine of \$109.00, \$134.00 court costs and \$5.00 arrest fee.

The court has reviewed the record and has carefully considered Appellants filed documents. In his written appeal, Appellant states the police officer mistook his vehicle for another car that passed Appellant traveling at a higher rate of speed. Appellant states he travels this road daily and would not speed as he knows police officers are always on this road.

This Court's jurisdiction is limited by law to determining whether the Trial Court committed an error of fact or law during the trial. Appellant's claim the police officer made a mistake is an issue of fact reserved for the Trial Court who is the exclusive trier of facts and the credibility of the witnesses.

There is no record of the evidence introduced before the Trial Court, and the record before this Court indicates no record was requested by Appellant.

This Court will not reverse the judgment of the Trial Court or overrule the Trial Court's factual findings without a record to review.

Therefore, the judgment of the Trial Court is affirmed.
