

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.64 OF TITLE II,
EL PASO CITY CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR A RETIREE
MEMBER ON THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

That Chapter 2.64 of Title II of the El Paso City Code is amended a follows:

Section 2.64.020 is amended to read as follows:

**2.64.020 Administration - Board of Trustees -
Composition**

Such fund shall be administered by a board of trustees composed of the mayor, two district representatives, two citizens of the city who are not officers or employees of the city and who have resided in the city for a period of at least two years immediately preceding their appointment, four city employees who are qualified to participate in the fund and one retired city employee receiving pension benefits from the fund and who is a resident of the city.

Section 2.64.030A is amended to change the second sentence thereof to read as follows:

The two citizens who are not officers or employees and the retiree member shall be appointed by the mayor.

Section 2.64.303B is amended to add the following at the end of the first paragraph:

The retiree member shall be appointed for a term of two years and he or his successors may be appointed or reappointed for terms of two years.

Section 2.64.030B is amended to change the third paragraph to read as follows:

APPROVED AND PASSED AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO, TEXAS, THIS 15TH DAY OF MARCH, 1988.

Each member of the board shall continue in office until his successor qualifies; provided, that if the mayor, a district representative, citizen, employee or retiree serving on such board shall cease to be such during his term, his place on the board shall immediately become vacant. The normal term of office for appointed citizens, elected employees or retirees shall begin on May 1st.
