

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 2, CHAPTER 2.64  
OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE (CITY EMPLOYEES' PENSION FUND)  
TO PROVIDE FOR NEW TERMS FOR CITY EMPLOYEE REPRESENTATIVES  
ON THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, TO PROVIDE FOR THE REMOVAL OF MEMBERS  
OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES IN CERTAIN CASES AND TO PROVIDE FOR  
REPLACEMENT IN CASE OF VACANCY IN THE RETIREE MEMBER POSITION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

That Section 2.64.030B is amended to read as follows:

The term of office for city employee representatives shall be three (3) years beginning with the election in 1993 to elect two city employee representatives whose terms expire and the election in 1994 to elect two city employee representatives whose terms expire. Thereafter, city employee representative elections to the board shall be held in the year in which a term expires, in accordance with the procedures set forth in subsection A, above.

That Section 2.64.030 is amended by adding a new subsection C to read as follows:

C. When a member of the Board of Trustees, other than the Mayor, is absent from three consecutive regular meetings without being excused by the board, the chairman, vice-chairman or secretary of the board shall report this fact to the board, so that consideration may be given to removal of such member.

That Section 2.64.040 is amended by changing the first sentence thereof to read as follows:

A vacancy on the board in the position held by a citizen representative, district representative or retiree shall be filled in the same manner as an original appointment and such appointment shall be for the unexpired term only.
