

RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMISSION ON BORDER RELATIONS TO REQUEST THAT THE MAYOR OF CIUDAD JUAREZ APPOINT A COMMISSION TO WORK WITH THE EL PASO COMMISSION ON BORDER RELATIONS; AND TO INSTITUTE A POLICY OF JOINT MEETINGS BETWEEN THE EL PASO CITY COUNCIL AND THE JUAREZ MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, the Commission on Border Relations (the "Commission") was formed by El Paso City Charter for the purpose of advising the City Council on matters concerning the City of El Paso and Ciudad Juarez;

WHEREAS, at a duly held meeting which took place on April 21, 1992, the Commission decided to forward the recommendations set forth below to the City Council of the City of El Paso ("City Council");

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the recommendations advanced by the Commission and decided to adopt the recommendations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO AS FOLLOWS:

1. Request to Ciudad Juarez. The Mayor and City Council request that the Mayor of Ciudad Juarez form a commission on border relations for the purpose of meeting with the Commission to share information and formulate recommendations for their respective governmental authorities on matters of interest to the border community.
2. Joint Meetings. The Mayor and City Council resolve to conduct joint meetings of an informal nature with their Juarez counterpart twice annually. The date, locations and agendas for those meetings shall be mutually agreed upon by both municipal authorities after receiving recommendations from the El Paso Commission and the Juarez Commission on border relations.
