BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

That the City Council agree to amend the Community Development Citizen Participation Plan adopted by City Council in January, 1988, as follows:


Add: Part I.E:

Conflicts of Interest: No application for funding with Community Development dollars will be accepted for consideration by the Steering Committee from an agency which has an employee, officer, agent or anyone who represents the agency in any capacity, sitting as a member of the Steering Committee.

Revise: Part III. B.2:

Steering Committee Meetings to Review Proposals: During the second step of the Application development, the Steering Committee as a whole shall review proposals submitted to develop a budget recommendation. The Committee shall not create subcommittees to review the proposals received. Residents, neighborhood associations, organizations, City Departments, etc., who submitted proposals may be invited to appear before the Steering Committee as a whole to briefly explain and justify the purpose and need for funding the proposals. The Steering Committee as a whole shall prioritize the projects reviewed.


