


RESOLUTION





I. Steering Committee for Citizen Participation

- A. Membership: A Steering Committee for Citizen Participation, henceforth referred to as the Steering Committee, shall consist of nine members as follows:
1. Nine persons of low or moderate income, or residents of Community Development eligible areas, or members of a population group that is defined as presumed benefit in 24 CFR 570.208 (a) (2) (i) (A) of the Community Development regulations.
 2. The Mayor and each City Representative will appoint one individual to the Steering Committee. Each individual appointee will be confirmed by City Council.
- B. Term of Office: Each confirmed Steering Committee member will serve a term of office for two years. One-half of the members terms shall expire each year on the second Tuesday of June.
- C. Grandfathering of Current Steering Committee Members: Current Steering Committee members will serve out their appointed term of office, at which time members will be appointed in consonance with paragraphs I, A1 and 2 above.
- D. Membership Termination: Any member of the Steering Committee who fails to attend three consecutive regular or called meetings of the Committee, or fails to attend at least eighty percent of all such regular or called meetings during any six-month period, will automatically lose membership on the Committee, unless such failure to attend is the result of personal hardship and is so determined by a majority vote of the Committee. Any vacancy on the Steering Committee shall be filled by the City Council for the remainder of the unexpired term. Any Steering Committee member may be removed from the Steering Committee by City Council, in accordance with provisions of the City Charter.
- E. Responsibilities: The Steering Committee shall serve in an advisory capacity to the City Council to identify community development and housing needs and formulate recommendations for the Community Development Program. Responsibilities of the Steering Committee shall include:
1. Review and comment on the development of a Citizen Participation Plan;
 2. Review statements-of-views and proposals submitted by citizens, neighborhood groups, City Departments, etc., and at public hearings;
 3. Review Community Development plans and projects prepared by City Departments and neighborhood organizations;
 4. Advise the City Council on policy decisions regarding program implementation;
