

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of El Paso, amended the Historic Landmark Preservation Ordinance on December 3, 1996;

**WHEREAS**, this amendment reduced terms of Historic Landmark Commission member appointments to two years;

**WHEREAS**, the ordinance, as amended, provides for the nine (9) member Commission to be achieved through attrition, wherein (1) one member is appointed by each district representative on the City Council, and one (1) member by the Mayor.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:**

THAT the following appointment schedule shall be utilized to meet the requirements of the ordinance as existing appointments expire or vacancies occur:

- (1) Representative District #8
- (2) Representative District #3
- (3) Representative District #7
- (4) Representative District #1
- (5) Representative District #6
- (6) Representative District #2
- (7) Representative District #4
- (8) Mayor
- (9) Representative District #5


