BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:





CITIZEN PARTICIPATION STRUCTURE

I. Steering Committee for Citizen Participation (Community-Wide Process)

A. Membership: A Steering Committee for Citizen Participation, hence-forth referred to as the Steering Committee, shall be composed of the following:

1. Three low and moderate income persons;
2. Three members of minority groups;
3. One representative of the elderly (person 60 years or greater)
4. One representative of the handicapped;
5. One representative of the youth;
6. No more than four other concerned persons who need not be low or moderate income who can make effective contributions consistent with the objectives of the Citizen Participation Plan;
7. Seven members, each low and moderate income, preferably from the Community Development eligible neighborhoods as recommended by the appropriate Alderman and/or Mayor. Each member shall maintain a liaison with the neighborhoods so as to facilitate communication between the Steering Committee, City Council and the neighborhood. Each member shall be required to present a report on Community Development to their neighborhood every month, based on information they have learned from the Steering Committee meetings and so on.
8. Not less than 50% + 1 of the composition of the Steering Committee shall be low and moderate income (low and moderate is defined as 80% of the median income of the SMSA Standard Metropolitan Statistical Area).

*Not necessarily low or moderate income.

- #### B. Terms of Office: Members of the Steering Committee shall be appointed to serve for two years, or until replaced. One-half of the members shall be appointed for terms that shall expire each year on the second Tuesday of June. No more than one-half of the Steering Committee membership shall expire in any given twelve-month period.
