El Paso Police Department request City Council approval to purchase Open Vision LT C-Arm Video X-Ray System from Envision Product Design, LLC, a sole source vendor, in the amount of \$59,771.31.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

The El Paso Police Bomb Squad Department needs to purchase a video imaging system deployable by robot. This imaging system will allow the bomb technician to immediately view 360 degree video images of internal components in a suspect package, remotely, using the robots existing video monitor. The department can also use this system during searches for illegal contraband that may be secreted inside vehicle, walls or any other types of containers.

Funds were identified for this purpose as part of an Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Program from the Office of the Governor Division of Emergency Management.




