SUBJECT:

An Ordinance amending Title 15 (Public Services), Chapter 15.08 (Street Rentals), Section 15.08.120 (Special Privilege Licenses and Permits), to delete the exception from the special privilege and sign permit requirement for signs located in the public right-of-way. All Districts.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

This amendment is in response to a request from the Economic Development, Planning and Tourism Legislative Review Committee to provide Council with the option to prohibit temporary signs from being placed within the parkways of public right-of-way or to allow them with requirement of a permit which would require that the signs meet specific design standards and spacing requirements.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 15 (PUBLIC SERVICES), CHAPTER 15.08 (STREET RENTALS), SECTION 15.08.120 (SPECIAL PRIVILEGE LICENSES AND PERMITS), OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE, TO DELETE THE EXCEPTION FROM THE SPECIAL PRIVILEGE AND SIGN PERMIT REQUIREMENT FOR SIGNS LOCATED IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF EL PASO:

1. That the El Paso City Code section 15.08.120(G)(11) shall be deleted in its entirety and marked as “Reserved.”
2. Except as herein amended, Title 15, Chapter 15.08, of the El Paso City Code remains in full force and effect.
