That the Purchasing Manager for Financial Services, Purchasing Division to be authorized to issue a Purchase Order(s) to Dell Computer Corp d/b/a Dell Marketing LP a State Department of Information Resources (DIR) contractor under DIR State contract number DIR-SDD-1014 for the renewal of SQL Server Processor Software Licenses, the total amount of \$230,059.20.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

The Information Technology Department is recommending that the Purchasing Manager, Financial Services, Purchasing Division, be authorized to issue a Purchase Order to Dell Marketing, Inc. of Austin, Texas, for the purchase of new PeopleSoft SQL Server Processor Software Licenses and includes two years of maintenance and support. The total amount is for \$230,059.20.

Due to the PeopleSoft reimplementation, moving towards a SQL Enterprise server model and additional servers is needed. An Enterprise SQL Server model is a per processor software licensing model which includes access for unlimited number of users or devices to connect from either inside or outside the firewall.

SELECTION SUMMARY:

Additionally, it is requested that the City Attorney's Office review and that the City Manager be authorized to execute any related contract documents and agreements necessary to effectuate this award.



The Information Technology Department is recommending the Purchasing Director, Financial Services, Purchasing Division, be authorized to issue a Purchase Order to Dell Marketing, Inc. to Dell Marketing Inc. of Austin, Texas, for the purchase of new PeopleSoft SQL Server Processor Software Licenses and includes two years of maintenance and support. The total amount is for \$230,059.20.

1. Is there an urgent need for the products/services? In other words is time of the essence?

Yes, the purchase addressed the number of servers needed and the move to an Enterprise Server model needed for PeopleSoft reimplementation.

2. Does the purchase through the Program promote the standardization of equipment?

Yes, the software licenses, support and maintenance being purchased is consistent with other equipment and software purchased and being upgrade for PeopleSoft reimplementation.

3. Does the purchase through the program support local business? If not is there a comparable product/service available locally?

No, Microsoft software licenses, support and maintenance are contracted through Dell Marketing, LP which is a Texas Department of Information Resources vendor.

4. Do the available vendors have prior work experience and/or familiarity with the City Of El Paso?

Yes, the vendor has worked on various contracts for the Information Technology department of the City providing hardware, software, maintenance and support.

5. Is the pricing reasonable as compared to other similar products/work performed for the City Of El Paso in the past or as quoted from other companies?

Yes, the prices were reviewed and determined to be reasonable, and reviewed and deemed reasonable by the Information Technology department. Additionally, as a DIR vendor, has met the States DIR contract services by using a competitive bidding process in the awarding of this contract. The participation by the City of El Paso in the Texas Department of Information Resources was approved by Mayor and City Council on February 27, 2007.
