Gerardo (Gerry) A. Licón, P.E. earned his Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering degree from the University of Texas at El Paso (UTEP) in 1986, and his Master of Science degree in Civil Engineering also from UTEP, along with his wife of 23 years (also a civil engineer), in 1999. He is a licensed Professional Engineer in the State of Texas and is the only El Paso engineer to have earned the prestigious Young Engineer of the Year award in the State of Texas, in 1996 from the Texas Society of Professional Engineers.

Gerry and his wife Margarita own Licon Engineering Co., Inc. (LEC Group), a women-owned, Small, Disadvantaged Business (SDB), and 8(a) certified business doing business with the private and public sectors.

He worked in the private sector, doing business with privately owned companies to develop residential, commercial and industrial projects. Gerry went on to become a partner in these companies, working on numerous projects ranging from small residential developments to large transportation and industrial infrastructure projects.

As a partner with his wife, Margarita at Licon Engineering Co., Inc., he has led project teams in engineering, environmental, design, and construction contracts for various municipal, state and federal agencies, including U.S. Army, U.S. Marine Corps, Homeland Security, Corps of Engineers, Department of Labor, and Housing and Urban Development, among others.

LEC Group is a fast-growing company which, in less than 8 years has grown into a multi-disciplined firm with over 50 permanent employees and offices in Texas, New Mexico, Nevada, California, and México.
