RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 18.50 of the El Paso Municipal Code, the City Council of the City of El Paso, by Resolution dated the 26th day of October, 2005, after due notice and hearing, ordered DANIEL AND GLORIA IRENE CHAVEZ, record Owners of the hereinafter described property that the Building be demolished within thirty (30) days and clean the premises of all weeds, trash, and debris all within thirty (30) days, and the Owners having failed after due notice to comply with such ORDER, any mortgagees, lienholders and other persons having an interest in the property have an additional ten (10) days to demolish the Building and clean the premises of all trash, debris, and the mortgagees, lienholders and other persons having an interest in the property failed after due notice to comply with such ORDER, the Street Department of the City of El Paso has been ordered to proceed to demolish the Building and clean the premises of all weeds, trash, and debris.

WHEREAS, the Director for Development Services Department has reported the cost of doing such work in the amount hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

1. That the City Council determines the actual cost of demolishing the Building and cleaning the premises of all weeds, trash and debris from the property, more particularly described as:

Lot 14, Block 1, Rosedale Farms No. 5, an addition in the City of El Paso, El Paso County, Texas according to the plat thereof on file in Volume 14, Page 1, Plat Records in the office of the County Clerk of El Paso County, Texas, municipally known and numbered as 21 Half Moon Drive, El Paso, Texas,

to be \$2,026.44, performed by the Street Department of the City of El Paso, and \$774.75, performed by the City Attorney's Office and the City Clerk's Office, making a total of \$2,801.19. The City Council finds that the work was completed on the 21st day of December, 2005, and approves the costs.

2. That the City Council, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code §214.001(n), declares the above total amount of TWO THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED ONE AND 19/100 DOLLARS (\$2,801.19) to be a lien on the above-described property.

3. That the City Clerk is directed to give notice of this lien by filing a copy of this Resolution for record with the County Clerk.

4. That all records of the City Clerk's Office relating to the proceeding against the above-described property are made a part of this Resolution by reference.


