An Ordinance amending Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 12.88 (Schedules), Section 12.88.180 (No Stopping or Standing – Tow-away Zone) Paragraph 111 (Oregon Street) of the El Paso City Code to remove the temporary suspension of No stopping or Standing – Tow-away Zone between Kerbey Avenue and Robinson Avenue and to extend the No Stopping or Standing – Tow-away Zone from Yandell Drive to Schuster Avenue, the penalty being as provided in Section 12.84.010 (Violation – Penalty) of the El Paso City Code (District 8).

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

This ordinance removes the temporary suspension of the existing No-Stopping or Standing – Tow-away Zone between Kerbey Avenue and Robinson Avenue and extends the No-Stopping or Standing – Tow-away Zone on Oregon Street between Yandell Drive and Schuster Avenue. The proposed expansion is requested in order to facilitate the expansion of the Smart 101 bus service routes.

PRIOR COUNCIL ACTION:

February 3, 2009: Ordinance No. 017068 established the No Stopping and Standing – Tow-away Zone on Oregon Street between Schuster Avenue and Glory Road.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 12 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), CHAPTER 12.88 (SCHEDULES), SECTION 12.88.180 (NO STOPPING OR STANDING – TOW-AWAY ZONE) PARAGRAPH 111 (OREGON STREET) OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE TO REMOVE THE TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF NO STOPPING OR STANDING TOW-AWAY ZONE BETWEEN KERBEY AVEUE AND ROBINSON AVENUE AND TO EXTEND THE NO STOPPING OR STANDING TOW-AWAY ZONE FROM YANDELL DRIVE TO SCHUSTER AVENUE, THE PENALTY BEING AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 12.84.010 (VIOLATION--PENALTY) OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

1. That Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 12.88 (Schedules), Section 12.88.180 (No stopping or standing – Tow-away zone) Paragraph 111 (Oregon Street) of the El Paso City Code shall be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

111. Oregon Street between Yandell Drive and Glory Road, both sides;

2. Except as expressly herein amended, Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 12.88 (Schedules), Section 12.88.180 (No stopping or standing-Tow-away zone) of the El Paso City Code shall remain in full force and effect.



Amend:

111. Oregon Street between Schuster Avenue to Glory Road, both sides, provided that the stopping or standing tow-away zone on Oregon Street between Kerbey Avenue and Robinson Avenue, both sides, shall be suspended until October 31, 2010 and thereafter the no stopping or standing tow-away zone shall be in full force and effect;

To read: 111. Oregon Street between Yandell Drive and Glory Road, both sides;

We request Council amend existing parking restrictions along Oregon Street to include the portion of Oregon between Schuster Avenue and Yandell Drive to facilitate the expansion of the Smart 101 bus service.
