## EXHIBIT "A"

The following is an approximate description of the boundaries of the Required Commercial Collection Area:

Beginning at the south east corner of the area located at the intersection of Kansas and Cesar Chavez ;

thence west along Cesar Chavez to Santa Fe;

thence north to Father Rahm;

thence north west to Paisano at Durango;

thence west and north along Paisano to Coldwell;

thence north along Coldwell projecting across the railroad tracks to Franklin;

thence west along Franklin to I-10;

thence east along I-10 to Campbell;

thence south along Campbell to Franklin;

thence along Franklin until it merges into I-10;

thence southeast across the railroad track to Virginia and then along Virginia to San Antonio;


thence west along San Antonio one block to Virginia;

thence south along Virginia to Paisano;

thence west along Paisano to Kansas;

thence south along Kansas to Cesar Chavez, the point of beginning of the area
