**List of Animal Related Activities from 1999 – 2009:**

- Served on the Animal Shelter Advisory Committee for 10 years
- Served as Secretary of the ASAC Board for 8 years and was responsible for recording and distributing minutes of monthly meetings
- Compiled a Directory of El Paso Animal Organizations and Resource Guide that was distributed to all veterinarians and rescue groups
- Organized and facilitated animal control adoptions at Pet Smart before the new shelter was built
- Coordinate with ASAC members and local rescue groups to participate in the annual Thanksgiving Day Parade promoting the spay/neuter message and adoption of pets from local shelters for the past six years.
- Responsible for animal control's participation in the Parade of Lights (Animal control drives the decorated spay/neuter van in the parade each year.)
- President of Pets Alive and active member of this organization since 2001
- Started the spay/neuter voucher program in El Paso by encouraging local vets to participate and processed all paperwork received from vets for payment (The Pets Alive Voucher Program administers funds from the city and has grown to the point a paid employee is needed to coordinate the program.)
- Foster abused and abandoned animals that need rehabilitation
- Organize the annual Howl O Wine Dog Walk held at La Vina Winery the Sunday before Halloween. (All proceeds cover the cost of spay/neuter for pets not qualifying under the voucher program.)
