

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, a National and Global Youth Service Day project of cleaning up Ascarate Park has been planned for April 21, 2007;

**WHEREAS**, funding is needed for supplies and drinks for the youth volunteers who will participate in this activity;

**WHEREAS**, Ascarate Park is located within the City limits, and uncleaned trash and debris from the Park can blow into area neighborhoods and on the City's rights-of-way and create an eyesore and health hazard;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that the activities conducted and promoted are of the same types of activities promoted by the City within its established programs and that providing funding to assist with this event constitutes an important public purpose or benefit to the City and citizens of El Paso for which the City expended discretionary funds.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

That the City Council finds that the activities conducted and promoted as part of the National and Global Youth Service Day project of cleaning up Ascarate Park constitutes an important public purpose to the City for the expenditure of District 3 discretionary funds in the amount of \$200.00.


