



## Franklin Mountain State Park

---

- In 1989, the PSB through City Council transferred over 6,833 acres to the state to expand the Franklin Mountain State Park
- In 2005, as part of Northeast and Northwest Master Planning, the PSB and staff worked with community stakeholders and City Council to identify and preserve open space through the state park system





## Franklin Mountain State Park

---

- The PSB worked with Texas Parks & Wildlife and our legislative delegation to provide state funding to purchase this land
- The State of Texas through its 80<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislative Session authorized the Texas Park and Wildlife Department, to proceed with the purchase of 1,659 acres for the Franklin Mountains State Park
- On Dec. 10, 2008, the PSB passed a resolution asking City Council to sell this land to the state for the expansion of the Franklin Mountain State Park



## Franklin Mountain State Park

---

- Land sale is comprised of 1,449 acres on the Eastside and 210 acres on the Westside
- The sales price was determined in accordance with the Memorandum of Policies concurred in by the City Council and Public Service Board of 1965. The sales price for this land conveyance is \$161,301.50
