Mark Cioc has taught modern European and American history at several universities over the past twenty years, most recently at New Mexico State University, Las Cruces. He has authored and edited six books and twenty-seven articles, and since 2006 has served as Editor of *Environmental History*, the official journal of the American Society for Environmental History. He became a resident of El Paso in 2004 and is currently writing a history of the city from 1848 to the present.
