Summary

In accordance with State of Texas bidding requirements, formal bids were obtained for this requirement. The award will establish a contract for a Traffic Signal Priority Control System for the El Paso Fire Department.

This is a system that will be installed at various intersections that will cause the traffic lights to turn green as a Fire Apparatus approaches the intersection. The Fire Department's future intent is to expand the use of this system to all emergency vehicles. The system is designed to avoid potential hazardous situations where a vehicle has to run a red light in order to let an emergency vehicle through a crowded intersection. The sole bid submitted by Consolidated Traffic Controls Inc. is being recommended for this contract.

Background Information

In February 2005, formal bids were requested from thirty-six companies/bidders in accordance with State of Texas bidding requirements. This solicitation was listed on the City's Internet web page and advertised in the El Paso Times (published February 8, 2005, and February 15, 2005). Bid packages were provided to a standard list of various contractor organizations, builder's exchanges and disadvantaged business organizations, for example, the Contract Opportunity Center and the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce.


One bid was received from Consolidated Traffic Controls, Inc. A number of vendors that did not bid were contacted as to why they did not respond. In a telephone call to Tomar Electronics, Daniel Sides regional sales manager, indicated that Tomar Electronics was to submit a bid through a local installer, Tri-State Electric. Unfortunately, Tri-State Electric backed out of the agreement without submitting a bid. Daniel Sides did not become aware of Tri-states decision until after the bid deadline had expired and therefore a bid from Tomar Traffic Control System was not received. Bob Llewellyn, owner of Hi-Tech Signal Inc., was contacted, but indicated that he did not carry this type of item. He recommended the 3M Opticom System, but Consolidated Traffic Controls Inc is the only distributor in Texas. Cisco Systems Inc. was also contacted. Sales consultant William Watson stated that Cisco Systems makes the electronic support equipment but did not make the emitters nor the receivers required, therefore did not submit a bid. In a call to Apfelaum Industrial Inc., sales manager Mike Collins said that he had contacted Consolidated Traffic Controls Inc. to offer their services as a local reseller for the 3M Opticom System, but was denied. Consolidated was going to bid the system themselves. Lightspeed Systems was also contacted and as per Bryan Thomas, they did not carry this type of item. Brown Traffic Inc. was also contacted. Cathy from their sales staff notified me that Texas is out of their sales territory and cannot bid in this state. Bob Charles from Pelco Products Inc. was also contacted. Pelco Products does not carry this type of item.

Fire Department staff has evaluated the sole bid submitted and recommends the sole bid for award. This sole bid is within the amount previously allocated by the Fire Department.


