SUBJECT:

Approve a resolution authorizing the City Manager to electronically submit a grant proposal to the United States Department of Justice for the Bulletproof Vest Partnership grant program in the amount of \$106,000.00 with a local cash match of \$106,000.00 for a total of \$212,000.00. In Accordance with Ordinance 16016 Section 1, which states "that unless a granting agency requires that the City's top elected official be listed as the grant official in a grant document, the City Council hereby designates the City Manager or his or her designee to be listed as the authorized official and as the official with financial authority or similar designations on all grant applications, acceptances, and other documents and to sign all grant applications, acceptances, and other grant documents on behalf of the City of El Paso." The signature of the "Highest Elected Official" is not required for electronic submittal; Resolution of Mayor and City Council is required.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

The Bulletproof Vest Partnership grant will fund the acquisition of 530 bulletproof vests for the El Paso Police Department. The Bulletproof Vest Partnership is a two-year grant.

PRIOR COUNCIL ACTION:

Yes. The City of El Paso received Bulletproof Vest Partnership funding in FY07.

AMOUNT AND SOURCE OF FUNDING:

Grant is in the amount of \$212,000.00 with a cash match of \$106,000.00.
\$81,262 of cash match requirement is being provided from Confiscated Fund #21150060-506000-16371-21000-500231; \$24,738 of cash match requirement is being provided from General Fund FY08, #21010050-506000-01101-21000.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

1. That the El Paso City Council approves submission of the grant application for the United States Department of Justice Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program to the United States Department of Justice.
2. The City Manager be authorized to sign the grant application including all understandings and assurances contained therein, as well as apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant in the amount of ONE HUNDRED SIX THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$106,000.00) from the El Paso Police Department to the United States Department of Justice, Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program, for the acquisition of 530 bulletproof vests for the El Paso Police Department.
3. The City of El Paso agrees to provide a total cash match in the amount of ONE HUNDRED SIX THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$106,000.00); EIGHTY ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND SIXTY TWO (\$81,262) will be paid from the Confiscated Fund account number 21150060-506000-16371-21000-500231 and TWENTY FOUR THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY EIGHT (\$24,738) will be paid from the General Fund account number 21010050-506000-01101-21000.


