If traffic control will be provided by the El Paso Police Department for a moving event, you must submit a map of the route for the event. The Rio Bravo Healthy Communities Council (RBHC) is a coalition of 7 organizations that includes members from El Paso, TX., Southern New Mexico, and Cd. Juarez, Chih. The coalition was formed for the purpose to create, nurture, and promote a healthy bi-national border community region by unifying our communities in collaborating together by advocating, exchanging skill, ideas, and support.

One priority the RBHC has identified in its community's needs assessment is the need to affirmatively address the family violence problem affecting our communities, especially against woman. As a strategy to promote fairness and equality for women, the RBHC is participating in a world-wide event in which organizations from 50 countries will develop a document that has been named "The Women's Global Letter" The purpose of this document is to promote the need of a world based on equality, liberty, solidarity, and peace.

The Women's Global Letter is traveling the 50 participating countries and its only stop in the United States will be in El Paso, Texas on April 27, 2005 at Armijo Park before it travels to Canada and continues it's final destination in Africa. The RBHC is coordinating a community forum on this day at 12:00 p.m. The purpose of the event is to promote available resources for victims of violence, discuss the needs our community faces, and hear victims' testimony to promote awareness of victims' rights. In addition, the coalition is planning a march at 1:30 p.m. from Armijo Park to the Downtown international port of entry located on Stanton St. to receive the document from our partnering organizations in Mexico at 2:00 p.m.


The RBHC is requesting the City of El Paso to wave the city permits and police escort fees associated with this event. As stated above, the RBHC is a coalition of organizations and it is not an incorporated entity. The coalition has submitted two grant proposals to the Robert Wood Johnson and Paso Del Norte Foundations for funding support but unfortunately non have been funded. The RBHC was approached to participate in this very important and symbolic act of solidarity approximately one month ago and because of the time and resources associated with the coordination of the event we have not been able to successfully fundraise any money. With the limited time available the BFHC has sent letters of request for financial support to corporation but we have not received any response. For this reason the RBHC does not have the funds to cover the cost of permits and services being requested from the City of El Paso.

Dear Ms. Olague,

The Parks and Recreation Department will allow Rio Bravo Healthy Communities to use a portion of Armijo Park located at 710 E. Seventh Avenue from 12:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 27, 2005 for a free public community fair and ceremony to provide information on available resources to prevent family violence. Tables and chairs will be used for this event.

The conditions placed on the activity are that an amplification permit from the Building Services Department will be required *if* amplification is used. The use of amplification would not go beyond 3:00 PM. **No vehicle will be driven or allowed onto the park grass areas.** There shall be no exchange of money in the park. No amusement devices or jumping balloons will be allowed in the park areas. No possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the park. All trash and litter generated by this activity will be removed from the park areas and contiguous area upon departure by event organizers. No restriction for the use of the park areas or streets by the public shall be imposed. No excavation or placing stakes into the ground will be allowed unless the location for such excavation or stake is approved and marked by the Department of Parks and Recreation.
