Mr. Padilla has been a paralegal for the Law Firm of Grambling & Mounce in El Paso, Texas and for the Diocesan Migrant & Refugee Services, Inc. in El Paso, Texas.

Over the past ten years, Mr. Padilla has been actively involved in the service of the Elderly and Disabled Community. He has been a consultant for several adult daycare as well as a director at TLC adult day care facility.
