

The Parks and Recreation Department will allow St. Mark United Methodist Church to use a portion of Marwood Park, located at 4325 Riverbend Dr. from 12:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 14, 2005 for an outreach event. A jumping balloon provided by Star Jump will be allowed. Free food, books, trophies will be given out.

The conditions placed on the activity are that an amplification permit from the Building Services Department will be required if amplification is used. The use of amplification would not go beyond 5:00 p.m. **No vehicle will be driven or allowed onto the park grass areas.** There shall be no exchange of money in the park. No possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the park. All trash and litter generated by this activity will be removed from the park areas and contiguous area upon departure. No restriction for the use of the park areas or streets by the public shall be imposed. No excavation or placing stakes into the ground will be allowed unless the location for such excavation or stake is approved and marked by the Department of Parks and Recreation.
