OBJECTIVE

SUMMARY

In order to achieve these these goals a study would be required that would establish personnel, payroll, vehicles, training, and control. Most of these requirements are already in place, and it would require only a gradual movement by the Mayor, City Manager and City Council over a period of say five years to be the best city in the nation regarding animal control. This study should be conducted by a small group of unbiased personnel that are not trying to serve their own agenda, and who take the well being of the present and future animals of El Paso, Texas seriously.
