

A RESOLUTION APPROVING SUPPORT FOR THE NOMINATION OF THE MONTANA AVENUE HISTORIC DISTRICT (1000 THROUGH 1500 BLOCKS OF MONTANA AVENUE) TO THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES BY THE TEXAS HISTORICAL COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso seeks to cooperate with the Texas Historical Commission on nominations of structures and historic districts to the National Register of Historic Places; and

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso actively seeks to preserve historic structures and is committed to encourage the nomination of districts to the National Register of Historic Places; and

WHEREAS the El Paso Historic Landmark Commission has recommended support of the nomination of the Montana Avenue Historic District (*1000 through 1500 blocks of Montana Avenue*) to the National Register of Historic Places; and

WHEREAS, the El Paso City Council finds that the nomination of the Montana Avenue Historic District (*1000 through 1500 blocks of Montana Avenue*) to the National Register of Historic Places will have no impact upon the public health, safety, morals and general welfare of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

That the City of El Paso actively supports the nomination of the Montana Avenue Historic District (*1000 through 1500 blocks of Montana Avenue*) to the National Register of Historic Places.




