Project Role:

The firm immediately was renamed PSR Architects, Inc and was later renamed to PSRBB Architects, Inc. in 1998 with the addition of two additional partners. Today, with reorganization, Mr. Razloznik is a Managing Principal of the firm and serves it's clients in a variety of capacities from Project Principal, Planner/Programmer to directing it's Marketing efforts.

Mr. Razloznik's interest in Architecture grew over the summers, during high school, spent doing residential and commercial construction. Upon graduating in 1971, he began his pursuit of an Architectural Degree at Texas Tech University. After graduating in May of 1976 with Bachelor of Architecture Degree, Design Option, he returned to El Paso and went to work for Design/Build Management Group, a Design/Build Contractor.

In January of 1977 he left Design/Build Management Group to form James H. Carr Architects, Inc. as a partner, while pursuing his Architectural registration. Upon obtaining his registration in the State of Texas in 1982, the firm name was changed to Carr / Razloznik Architects, Inc. where he remained and practiced, specializing in Educational Architectural design before leaving to join PSA Architects. At PSRBB he has headed up the Educational / Institutional Division since 1990 to the present.

Mr. Razloznik has been very active in the profession and civically, by serving in various positions from secretary to President of the El Paso Chapter of AIA and as TSA Director from 1996 thru 1998. He was previously on the Board of Directors for the YMCA for thirteen years serving as Chairmen of the Building and Maintenance Committee for a number of years. He was a committee member at El Paso Community College on implementing the under-graduate Architectural curriculum in obtaining reciprocal compliance with Texas Tech University. He is, also, a past President and Board Member of the Texas Tech Architectural Alumni Association.
