John Karlsruhe, P.E.

John Karlsruhe, P. E. is a licensed engineer in Texas, New Mexico and Arizona. He is also a licensed contractor in New Mexico, holding licenses for GA98, GF04 and GF09. John has over 34 years experience in the civil engineering design and heavy highway construction. In addition to his responsibilities as President of CSA Engineers & Constructors he also serves as Principal-in-Charge of CSA Design Group Inc. a civil engineering design firm. Both firms are co-located in northwest El Paso.

Mr. Karlsruhe began his career as a Project Engineer for Texas Utilities Company and developed extensive experience in the construction management of multi-million dollar power plants. He managed construction projects at Martin Lake Steam Electric Station; Monticello Steam Electric Station and Twin Oak Steam Electric Station. His duties on these projects included preparation of cost estimates, budgets, schedules, bid documents, evaluation of bids, contract award and administration of the construction contract. Since returning to El Paso in 1991 Mr. Karlsruhe has provided project management and engineering design oversight of numerous city, county and state heavy highway design projects. In addition to heavy civil works projects he has designed industrial parks, residential subdivisions, water and wastewater projects, drainage projects including Conditional and Final Letters of Map Revision (CLOMR/LOMR). In 1996 Mr. Karlsruhe started his own civil engineering firm, Karlsruhe Inc. dba CSA Consulting Engineers now known as CSA Engineers & Constructors. In 2006 he formed a new entity for civil engineering design, CSA Design Group, Inc.
