I have been asked to provide some backup information regarding the St Ignatius item I put on our agenda.

As you may know, this church was built in the early 1900's and is one of the oldest churches in historic Segundo Barrio. Many of the systems in the building are in need of repair or replacement. For example all of the lighting and wiring needs to be replaced and upgraded.

The church is trying to raise the money from the residents of the Segundo Barrio community and from people who were raised in the Barrio and now reside in other parts of the city. In order to do this they are planning a Kermes or Festival to celebrate the Feast Day of the namesake for the church. Closure of this street during the weekend will have little negative and much positive impact on the community.

I am looking forward to discussing this with members of the council at Tuesday's meeting.
