AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 12(VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), CHAPTER 12.88 (SCHEDULES), SECTION 12.88.150 (SCHEDULE XIV, SPEED LIMITS), OF THE EL PASO MUNICIPAL CODE, TO TEMPORARILY REDUCE THE EXISTING SPEED LIMIT OF 60 M.P.H. TO 50 M.P.H. ON US 54 BETWEEN HONDO PASS DRIVE AND YANDELL DRIVE FOR THE DURATION OF THE US 54 CONSTRUCTION PROJECT. THE PENALTY BEING AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 12.84.010 OF THE EL PASO MUNICIPAL CODE.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 12 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), CHAPTER 12.88 (SCHEDULES), SECTION 12.88.150 (SCHEDULE XIV, SPEED LIMITS), OF THE EL PASO MUNICIPAL CODE, TO TEMPORARILY REDUCE THE EXISTING SPEED LIMIT OF 60 M.P.H. TO 50 M.P.H. ON US 54 BETWEEN HONDO PASS DRIVE AND YANDELL DRIVE FOR THE DURATION OF THE US 54 CONSTRUCTION PROJECT. THE PENALTY BEING AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 12.84.010 OF THE EL PASO MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

1. That Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 12.88 (Schedules), Section 12.88.150 (Schedule XIV, Speed Limits), of the El Paso Municipal Code shall be and hereby is amended to add a new subparagraph as follows:

Temporary reduction of the existing 60 m.p.h. speed limit to 50 m.p.h., on U.S. 54 between Hondo Pass Drive and Yandell Drive, for the duration of the U.S. 54 construction project;

2. Except as expressly herein amended, Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 12.88 (Schedules), Section 12.88.150 (Schedule XIV, Speed Limits), of the El Paso Municipal Code shall remain in full force and effect.


