BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

St. Ignatius Church is seeking permission to sell and serve alcoholic beverages within closed portions of City right-of-way on Nino Aguilera Street between East Delta Drive and East Third Avenue and East Third Avenue between South Park Street and Nino Aguilera Street from 5:00 pm to 12:00 am Friday, July 27, Saturday, July 28 and Sunday, July 29, 2012 in conjunction with the St. Ignatius Church Bazaar.

A special privilege permit (NESV12-00021) was approved by for the temporary street closure.

As part of the approval process, the applicant has provided insurance, with the City named as co-insured. The applicants are also required to obtain all necessary permits to sell and serve food and beverages. The TABC (Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission) requires City Council authorization in order to issue a temporary permit for the event.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

WHEREAS, St. Ignatius Catholic Church (hereinafter referred to as “Grantee”) is sponsoring St. Ignatius Church Bazaar (hereinafter referred to as “Event”), from Thursday, July 26, 2012 through Sunday, July 29, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the City is not a sponsor of the Event and the Grantee assumes full responsibility for the planning, coordination, management and production of the Event; and

WHEREAS, the Grantee has received administrative approval for a Special Privilege Permit for the use and closure of City rights-of-way for more than twenty-four (24) hours on portions of City rights-of-way on Nino Aguilera Street between East Delta Drive and East Third Avenue and East Third Avenue between South Park Street and Nino Aguilera Street, from 8:00 am Thursday, July 26, 2012 to 12:00 am Monday, July 30, 2012, in conjunction with the proposed Event; and

WHEREAS, the Grantee desires to provide for the sale and serving of alcoholic beverages on the closed portions of City rights-of-way during the Event; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission requires that the city Council for the City of El Paso approve, as a permissible activity, the sale and service of alcoholic beverages within City right-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

That the sale and service of alcoholic beverages by St. Ignatius Church, in the closed portions of City rights-of-way on Nino Aguilera Street between East Delta Drive and East Third Avenue and East Third Avenue between South Park Street and Nino Aguilera Street from 5:00 pm Friday, July 27, 2012 to 12:00 am Saturday, July 28, 2012, 5:00 pm Saturday, July 28, 2012 to 12:00 am Sunday, July 29, 2012 and 5:00 pm Sunday, July 29, 2012 to 12:00 am Monday, July 30, 2012, in conjunction with the St. Ignatius Church Bazaar, is a permissible activity.
