**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 014680,
FOR THE PURPOSE OF ABOLISHING THE AD HOC WASTE TIRE DISPOSAL
ADVISORY COMMITTEE.**

WHEREAS, the Ad Hoc Waste Tire Disposal Advisory Committee (the "Committee") was created to receive public input and provide recommendations to City Council regarding the pervasive health, safety and aesthetic problem of abandoned tires throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the Committee is to disband upon the completion of its work as determined by City Council; and

WHEREAS, in 2004, the City revised applicable ordinances, which, among other things, eliminated the need to continue the Committee; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso agrees to abolish the Committee.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

That the Committee, established October 31, 2000 by Ordinance No. 014680, be abolished, and that Ordinance No. 014680 be repealed.




