AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 12 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), CHAPTER 12.88 (SCHEDULES), SECTION 12.88.030 (SCHEDULE III – PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS) OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE DELETING THE PROHIBITION OF PARKING ON COLDWELL STREET FROM SAN FRANCISCO AVENUE TO PAISANO DRIVE ON EITHER SIDE; THE PENALTY BEING AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 12.84.010 (VIOLATION--PENALTY) OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

The Engineering Department Traffic Division is requesting an ordinance be drafted to delete the parking restriction on Coldwell Street from San Francisco Avenue to Paisano Drive on either side. This parking deletion will increase the parking capacity in the Union Plaza Entertainment District. It is therefore the recommendation of the Engineering Traffic Division to proceed with this restriction.



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 12 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), CHAPTER 12.88 (SCHEDULES), SECTION 12.88.030 (SCHEDULE III – PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS) OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE DELETING THE PROHIBITION OF PARKING ON COLDWELL STREET FROM SAN FRANCISCO AVENUE TO PAISANO DRIVE ON EITHER SIDE; THE PENALTY BEING AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 12.84.010 (VIOLATION--PENALTY) OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

Section 1. That Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 12.88 (Schedules), Section 12.88.030 (Schedule III – Parking prohibited at all times on certain streets) of the El Paso City Code shall be and hereby is amended to delete the following street:

2. Coldwell Street from San Francisco Avenue to Paisano Drive on either side.

Section 2. Except as expressly herein amended, Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 12.88 (Schedules), Section 12.88.030 (Schedule III – Parking prohibited at all times on certain streets) of the El Paso City Code shall remain in full force and effect.





