SUBJECT: Neighborhood Traffic Management Program

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There has been a very good public response to this new program, and the Traffic Division received 109 applications as of June 2, 2008, which was the closeout date for the initial round of applications. We have reviewed all of these applications and have conducted traffic studies to determine eligibility and priority. A list of the applications is attached. We have also begun the notification process to the applicants.

32 applications were found to be eligible for consideration of physical traffic calming measures. These applications were further investigated and rated under the approved criteria, and we expect to have the results of the rating process completed very soon. A presentation will be made to City Council once the ratings are verified. Staff will then work with the residents in each area to select the most appropriate traffic calming measures to be installed, and will implement as many projects as possible with available funding. Qualified applications that are not funded in this initial round will be held over and reconsidered with the next round of applications.

18 applications were found to be eligible for non-physical traffic calming measures, such as signage or striping. Staff has already begun to develop recommendations for those areas. In addition, we will request additional enforcement from the police regional command centers.

59 applications were not eligible under the program guidelines, for a variety of reasons. In most of these cases the field investigations did not find that vehicle speeds met the program threshold (an 85 percentile speed of 35 mph or higher), or the street was classified in the City's Major Thoroughfare Plan as a major or minor arterial street, or the request was for a stop sign, signal, or some other issue that is not eligible under this program.
