WORKING FOR THE TEXAS STATE NETWORK'S FLAGSHIP STATION, KFJZ, OWNED BY SID RICHARDSON, IT WAS THE BEGINNING OF AN EXCITING CAREER. SINCE THE EARLY DAYS AS SALES MANAGER AT KFJZ IN FORT WORTH, JIM HAS A LONG TRACK RECORD THAT INCLUDES BEING A SHAREHOLDER AND OPERATOR OF BROADCAST PROPERTIES IN TEXAS, LOUISIANA, SOUTH CAROLINA, ARIZONA, AND NEVADA. HIS BROADCAST HIGHLIGHTS INCLUDE BEING PRESIDENT OF THE TEXAS ASSOCIATION OF BROADCASTERS, TEXAS BROADCASTER OF THE YEAR, A DIRECTOR AND MEMBER OF THE TEXAS RADIO HALL OF FAME, SERVING ON THE ARBITRON RATINGS COUNCIL AND VARIOUS STATE AND NATIONAL COMMITTEES.
