Dear Mr. Miranda:

Reference is made to your application of August 4, 2005 requesting use of Montana Ave. (sidewalk) for the proposed Xavier Miranda/Answer Demonstration on Monday, August 29, 2005.

It is not our desire to discourage this activity, but we need to stress the outright danger involved in using state highways for this type of activity. We must, in good judgment, recommend against the use of these highways for the proposed Xavier Miranda/Answer Demonstration. If, after consideration of the danger and liability involved, your organization remains resolute in its intentions, then this department can only suggest you comply with the following guidelines to provide safety for the event:

1. The local authorities, El Paso Police Department, shall provide adequate traffic control throughout portions of the Xavier Miranda/Answer Demonstration. This shall include advance warnings to motorists and motorized escorts by police units to ensure that the traveling public is aware of participants as well as more areas of safety by slowing down motorists.
2. Preparation and termination areas of event shall be located off the highway right-of-way.
3. It is recommended the event proceed in the same direction as the normal traffic flow.
