Please be advised that three court reporter contracts will appear on the City Council Agenda for August 17, 2004. The court reporters are Dee Ann Boyd, Janie Ruiz and Max Venzor. As a court of record, Municipal Court is obligated to provide a record of the court proceedings whenever one is requested. The three court reporters are contracted to serve on assigned dates in the various courts, covering early morning, midday and evening court sessions. They are paid only for the sessions worked: \$60.00 for the first hour and a half and \$30.00 for each additional hour.

The total amount budgeted yearly for court reporters is \$ 40,000.

INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR CONTRACT

COUNTY OF EL PASO

This contract for Court Reporting Services in the Municipal Court is entered into this 17th day of August 2004, by and between the **CITY OF EL PASO, TEXAS** (City) and **DEE ANNE BOYD** (Court Reporter), and the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Court reporting services are to be provided in municipal Courts at the time assigned by a Court Reporter Schedule which will be issued by the Municipal Court Clerk on a monthly basis. Court Reporter will be assigned to Court No. 5 at 6:00 p.m. but assignments to provide court reporting services at times other than provided in the monthly schedule will be made from time to time, as needed. Compensation for those services will be as stated in Section 2.

2. Rate of compensation shall be \$60.00 for each jury and non-jury court session which does not exceed one and one-half (1½) hours. Service at a jury or non-jury court session which exceeds one and one-half (1½) hours shall be compensated at a rate of \$60.00 for the first one and one-half (1½) hours plus \$30.00 per hour for that period of court reporting time which exceeds one and one-half (1½) hours.

3. Payment for the cost of providing a typed transcription of a case record for a Statement of Facts requested by the Defendant is to be made by the Defendant under the terms of contract between the Court Reporter and the Defendant.

4 The Court Reporter shall be compensated for services performed in the previously ended calendar month upon submittal of an invoice to the City Comptroller, P.O. Box 1919, El Paso, Texas 79550. A copy of this monthly invoice is to be submitted to the Municipal Clerk for verification purposes.

5. In the event the Court Reporter is unable to attend a scheduled assignment, the Court Reporter may designate a replacement to provide the court reporting services. It is the Court Reporter's responsibility to ensure that only Court Reporters certified by the State of Texas to perform such services are designated as replacement. Payment in all cases will be made by the City of El Paso to the undersigned Court Reporter.

6. Unless previously terminated, this contract shall be in effect from September 1, 2004 through August 31, 2005 inclusive.

7. This contract may be terminated prior to expiration date by either party upon the submittal ten (10) working days advance written notice.

8. Nothing herein shall be construed as creating a relationship of employer and employee between the Parties. The City shall not be subject to any obligations or liabilities of the Contractor incurred in the performance of this contract unless otherwise herein authorized. The Contractor expressly agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City for any and all liabilities and obligations incurred due to any breach of contract or negligent acts or omissions or other defalcations on the part of the Contractor.

9. For purposes of determining the place of the contract and the law governing the same, it is agreed that the contract is entered into in the City and County of El Paso, State of Texas, and shall be governed by the laws of the State of Texas. Venue for all purposes shall be El Paso County, Texas.

10. This contract constitutes and expresses the entire contract between the parties hereto in reference to the temporary services of the Contractor for the City, and in reference to any of the matters or things herein provided for, or hereinbefore discussed or mentioned in reference to such services, all promises, representations and understanding relative thereto herein being merged.
