SUBJECT:

An ordinance to amend the City code to reflect departmental reorganization by amending Title 6 (Vehicles for hire) to amend section 6.40.110 (Personnel, Vehicles and Equipment-Standards and Requirements) to reassign the duties of the Development Services Department and the staff; the penalty being as provided in section 6.40.130 of the El Paso City code.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

The City Manager proposed through the Budget for FY 2011 and the City Council has decided to re-organize the Engineering Department, the Street Department, the Environmental Services Department and to delete the Development Services Department. This action necessitates this ordinance and others to make changes to the City Code to reflect the organizational changes. No substantive changes are being made to the code in this ordinance--only the changes necessary to achieve reorganization and to make appropriate cross references to other code provisions.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY CODE TO REFLECT DEPARTMENTAL REORGANIZATION BY AMENDING TITLE 6 (VEHICLES FOR HIRE) TO AMEND SECTION 6.40.110 (PERSONNEL, VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT—STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS) TO REASSIGN THE DUTIES OF THE DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT AND THE STAFF; THE PENALTY BEING AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 6.40.130 OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE.

WHEREAS, the Building Permits and Inspections Division of the Development Services Department is being moved to be a division of the Engineering and Construction Management Department, which is being reorganized and renamed; and

WHEREAS, various provisions in the City Code need to be amended to reflect this change.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

Section 1. That Chapter 6.40 (Emergency and Transfer Ambulance Services), Section 6.40.110 (Personnel, vehicles and equipment—Standards and requirements—Inspection), of the El Paso City Code, is amended to change the phrase “deputy director for building services” to “chief of the fire department or designee” as used in this section.

Section 50. This ordinance shall take effect on September 1, 2010.

Section 51. Except as herein amended, Title 6 of the El Paso City Code shall remain in full force and effect.
