SUBJECT: ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 12 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), CHAPTER 12.44 (STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING GENERALLY), SECTION 12.44.180 (REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO CERTAIN SPECIAL SITUATIONS), SUBSECTION B, TO AMEND TO READ FUNERAL ZONE: MUST BE ADJACENT TO A MORTUARY, FUNERAL HOME, OR CHURCH. VEHICLES OF THE MORTUARY OR FUNERAL HOME, WHILE USED IN ITS BUSINESS, MAY USE THE ZONE AT ANY TIME; OTHER VEHICLES MAY NOT PARK OR STAND IN THE ZONE EXCEPT WHEN PART OF A FUNERAL PROCESSION. THE PENALTY BEING AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 12.48.010 (VIOLATION--PENALTY) OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

This ordinance is being amended at the request from Reverend Molina, Pastor at Our Lady Of Assumption Church. The Engineering Traffic Division has received requests for funeral zone installations in front of churches. The Engineering Traffic Division has concluded that there is a need to provide funeral zones by churches but the existing ordinances only permits these type of installations next to mortuaries/funeral homes. Therefore it is this Division's recommendation that this ordinance be amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

1. That Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 12.44 (Stopping, Standing and Parking Generally), Section 12.44.180 (Regulations pertaining to certain special situations), Subsection B, Subparagraph 2 (Funeral Zone) of the El Paso City Code shall be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

B2. Funeral Zone: Must be adjacent to a mortuary, funeral home, or church. Vehicles of the mortuary or funeral home, while used in its business, may use the zone at any time; other vehicles may not park or stand in the zone except when part of a funeral procession.

2. Except as expressly herein amended, Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 12.44 (Stopping, Standing and Parking Generally), Section 12.44.180 (Regulations pertaining to certain special situations.), Subsection B, Subparagraph 2 (Funeral Zone) of the El Paso City Code shall remain in full force and effect.

"Funeral home" means a facility for the arrangement of funerals and the preparation of the dead for burial or cremation.
