SUBJECT:

A Resolution that City Council amend the City's 2007-2008 Annual Action Plan of the Consolidated Plan for 2005-2010 by deleting one homeownership assistance activity: Affordable Housing Credit Union Service Organization (AHCUSO) – Individual Development Account (IDA) Program - \$125,000, and that the City Manager or her designee be authorized to take any actions necessary to accomplish the intent of the resolution.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:

On August 17, 2009, AHCUSO voluntarily made a decision to not utilize the 33rd Year homeownership assistance funds awarded to them for their IDA Program, which involved \$125,000 from the City of El Paso to match savings of a minimum of 112, low income, first-time homebuyer families towards the purchase of a new home. The City and AHCUSO were unable to reach a contractual agreement for the use of these funds. The City wanted to provide their matching funds on a case-by-case basis after each family was qualified and deemed eligible to receive assistance. AHCUSO wanted the City to provide the entire \$125,000 up front. Thus, the financial set-up of this project could not be achieved. AHCUSO will still be able to match up to 62 families utilizing other match funds that they've secured.

A Notice was placed in the El Paso Times and El Diario newspapers on August 21, 2009 to allow a 30-day period for public comment ending September 21, 2009. Any citizen comments received after the submittal of this Agenda Item Department Head's Summary Form will be forwarded to City Council for consideration.

Yes, additions and deletions to the City's Annual Action Plans are not uncommon, as amendments have been approved in the past by City Council to previous Annual Action Plans.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2007, the City Council for the City of El Paso adopted a Final Action Plan for 2007-2008 for the Consolidated Plan 2005-2010, including the 33rd Year (2007-2008) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program; and

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2008, the City Council, based on the recommendation of the Director of Community and Human Development and Department staff, amended the Annual Action Plan (2007-2008) and 33rd Year (2007-2008) CDBG Program Budget by adding the Affordable Housing Credit Union Service Organization – Individual Development Account Program - \$125,000, a homeownership assistance activity designed to match savings of a minimum 112 low income, first-time homebuyer families towards the purchase of a home in the El Paso area; and

WHEREAS, based upon the recommendation of the CD Steering Committee and the Director of the Community and Human Development Department and the agency's decision to withdraw its funding request, the City Council, now desires to amend the Annual Action Plan (2007-2008) and 33rd Year (2007-2008) CDBG Program Budget by deleting one homeownership assistance activity; and

WHEREAS, on August 21, 2009, the City of El Paso published in the El Paso Times and El Diario newspapers public notice and allowed a 30-day public comment period regarding the proposed amendment to the Annual Action Plan (2007-2008) and 33rd Year (2007-2008) CDBG Program Budget, and City Council has duly considered public comment, if any.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

1. That the Annual Action Plan (2007-2008) and 33rd Year (2007-2008) CDBG Program Budget is hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) the homeownership assistance activity, “Affordable Housing Credit Union Service Organization – Individual Development Account - \$125,000 (**All Districts**)” is deleted; and
 - (b) the funds from the above project remain in the Community Development Contingency Account (Account No. G7129CD0001).
2. That the City Manager or her designee be authorized to take any actions necessary to accomplish the intent of the resolution.
