**\*RESOLUTION**

That Chapters 2, 3, and 4 of the Community and Human Development Department Housing Programs Division Program Guidelines Handbook is hereby revised to read as attached Exhibit "A". Such revisions include: **1)** Program name changes to Single Family Owner Occupied Home Renovation Program (Chapter 2) and name change from Emergency Repair to Minor Repair Program (Chapter 4); **2)** a decrease in the interest rate for all programs from 3% to 0%; **3)** a new Home Renovation loan program for senior citizens and disabled, with a 15 year 0% interest forgivable deferred payment loan; **4)** additional assistance not included in the program maximum of \$65,000 for the Renovation and Reconstruction programs include Accessibility modifications – up to \$20,000; Lead, Mold, Asbestos abatement – up to \$20,000; and Relocation (during renovation/abatement) up to \$3,000; **5)** Historic properties may receive up to an additional \$10,000 for compliance with historic regulations; and **6)** Minor Repair Program assistance amount for eligible work will be \$4,999 and the loan terms will be an Unsecured 2-year Forgivable Loan.

**\*RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, on November 9, 1999, the City Council passed a resolution adopting an apprenticeship program for city building construction projects; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 1, 2010 the City Council adopted a new apprenticeship program for city building construction projects which replaced the apprenticeship program adopted in 1999; and

**WHEREAS**, The purpose of the apprenticeship program is to require that only journeyman and apprentices registered in an apprentice program certified by the United States Department of Labor (DOL) perform work on applicable city construction projects in order to ensure both quality construction work as well as providing training opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, A DOL certified apprenticeship program requirement is consistent with the state prevailing wage rate law; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to adopt a new apprenticeship program to add additional occupations to the list of apprenticeable occupations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:**

That the following apprenticeship program is adopted, replacing the apprentice program adopted on June 1, 2010:

1. City construction contracts shall require that the construction contractors performing work for the City and their sub-contractors for such contract shall participate in a DOL certified apprenticeship program when the work required under the contract includes work that must be performed by apprenticeable occupations and the work involving such apprenticeable occupation has a value of fifty thousand dollars or more. The apprenticeable occupations are those listed in **Exhibit A** attached hereto.
2. When applicable, the contractor shall hire registered apprentices enrolled in a DOL certified apprenticeship program.
3. The contractor shall not substitute unregistered apprentices to perform apprentice level work in place of registered apprentices.
4. The contractor shall pay wage rates and benefits for apprentices at the rate determined by the DOL apprenticeship program.
5. The contractor shall comply with the DOL requirements governing the ration of apprentices to journeymen.
6. The City Engineer may evaluate the availability of DOL certified apprentices as necessary and adjust the schedule of apprenticeable occupations listed in **Exhibit A** as such apprenticeable occupations are available within the community.
7. Construction contracts shall provide that noncompliance of the contract provisions concerning the apprenticeship participation may be a basis to terminate the construction contract, which shall be referred to the City Council for determination.
8. Prior to the start of the work of the applicable apprenticeable occupations listed in **Exhibit A**, the contractor or the applicable subcontractor shall provide written certification to the city that it is a sponsor or participant in a DOL approved apprenticeship program.

**\*RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the City of El Paso is required by Chapter 2258 of the Texas Government Code to determine the prevailing rate of per diem wages for each craft or type of worker within the geographic limits of the City for construction of public works;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 2258 .022(a)(1) and in conjunction with other local governmental bodies, the City conducted a survey of wages received by classes of workers employed on projects of a character similar to the contract work performed within the El Paso city limits; and

**WHEREAS**, the City, along with a representative group of contractor and craft/union leaders, reviewed the survey results within the El Paso city limits and the rates established by the U.S. Department of Labor in accordance with the Davis Bacon Act, and agreed to recommend to the El Paso City Council for adoption as the 2012 City of El Paso Prevailing Wages, certain rates for each craft or type of worker for Building Construction Trades and the definitions of the work performed by each craft or type of worker; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 11, 2013, City Council adopted the 2012 City of El Paso Prevailing Wage Rates as the minimum wages which shall be paid to all workers employed on public works projects within the City of El Paso; and

**WHEREAS**, the City now desires to add two inadvertently omitted classifications to the 2012 City of El Paso Prevailing Wages adopted on June 11, 2013.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:**

That two classifications of worker which were inadvertently omitted from the list of classifications in the 2012 City of El Paso Prevailing Wages adopted by City Council on June 11, 2013, be added to the list and that the City Engineer is authorized to specify the wage rates as attached in Exhibit A for those classifications of worker for Building Construction Trades in the call for bids for any public works contract and in the contract itself and that the City Engineer be authorized to clarify the definitions of work performed by those classifications of worker if necessary.
