

# Mission Statement




## Overall Goal


- To provide a FREE Designated Driving service to citizens of Fort Bliss and El Paso.

- 04 OCT 2012 – Insurance Obtained to allow Operations to begin
- 05 OCT 2012 – Operations begin for Fort Bliss and El Paso citizens
- 05 OCT 2013 – Final weekend of first year of operations



## FY2013 Results – Services

---

- Total Patrons Transported: 2,429
- Total Vehicles Transported: 1,412
- Fort Bliss : 25.2% decrease in total number of D.W.I.'s as compared to FY2012
- El Paso: 23.1% decrease in total Alcohol Related Traffic Fatalities as compared to 2012






