



The reviewing stand will be on the south side of San Jacinto Plaza on Mills St. Staging areas to be used: Florence, Ochoa, Virginia, St. Vrain, and one block on east side of Myrtle. Approximately 1,300 persons, 100 vehicles will take part and 4,000-5,000 spectators are anticipated. IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING TRAFFIC CONTROL:

If traffic control will be provided by the El Paso Police Department for a moving event, you must submit a map of the route for the event. The Police Department will then prepare a traffic control plan along with an estimated cost for their services as provided in Section 13.32.110. You will be billed for the actual cost after the event.

If traffic control will not be provided by the El Paso Police Department, then you must submit a map and written traffic control plan to Building Permits & Inspections or the Engineering/Traffic Division, not less than seven days prior to the date of the event.

You will also be responsible for paying for and providing any barricades and signs. The barricading shall be manned and the barricading and signing shall comply with the provisions set forth in the State's

"Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices." Please feel free to contact the City's Engineering/Traffic Division, 6th Floor, 541-4050, for more information.

Additionally, other ordinances may apply to or restrict the use of city-owned property, including parks.

9. Method of Street and Right-of-Way cleaning:

Section 13.32.100 requires you to clean the streets, sidewalks, and other rights-of-way from all event litter and debris, including that left by spectators. In the event that you do not clean these areas, the City may perform such cleaning and you will be charged. You may also arrange in advance to have the Street Department perform the cleaning for a charge by filling out a separate request form and submitting it to Building Permits & Inspections Office no later than fourteen days prior to the date of the event.



Dear City Council Members,

The members of the United American Veterans Organization of El Paso are asking the City Council to support the Annual Veterans Day Parade. It will be held on November 6, 2004, in downtown El Paso. Enclosed is the proposed parade route. The parade will start at 10:45 a.m.

We are asking for a permit and a police escort. We are also asking that all parade fees and the police escort fees be waived. We feel it will serve a significant public purpose to waive these fees and honor the veterans who have and are currently serving our country and those who gave their all. There will be no animal participation in the parade, therefore, Street Cleaners will not be required.

The UAVO is a non-profit organization funded solely by membership dues and donations from the veterans organizations in El Paso. This money is primarily used for parade expenses which includes approximately \$150 per school bus to transport the local school bands and JROTC, and police escort, if not waived, etc. We have requested support from Fort Bliss for the mobile stage and the chairs for the reviewing stand.

The Vietnam Veterans of America will provide insurance to cover the parade in the amount of \$3,000.

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The United American Veterans Organization is made up of all the veteran's organizations in El Paso. We joined together to form an entity to have an Annual Veterans Day Parade. All the efforts that go into this organization are volunteer.

The only financial documentation we can furnish would be a copy of our Bank Statement or Monthly Financial Report. We currently have \$6,758.65 in the Bank of America in a checking account.

We have used these funds very sparingly. In addition to the parade costs we have and are currently working on upgrading the Avenue of Flags at the Fort Bliss National Cemetery at the cost of approximately \$700.00, part of which is still outstanding. We are currently working on obtaining new storage containers and a new storage building to preserve the flags that are used on the Avenue of Flags, as these flags are very precious, as all flags flown at Fort Bliss National Cemetery must have been used to cover a veterans coffin.

Our annual income normally comes from \$45.00 dues from each organization, which totals approximately \$1,300 per year, plus any donations from these members organizations.

Our expenses include the parade steamers for \$80, the plaques and trophies for \$180, postage and other expenses to organize the parade for \$250, hot dogs and cool aid for the Boy Scouts who put up the small grave flags at the Fort Bliss National Cemetery for Memorial Day and Veterans Day for \$120, and the transportation for the local school bands and JROTC's to participate in the parade, approximately \$1700. Without unforeseen expenses, this totals \$2,330, and takes more than our income. This is where we use the surplus in our checking account at the current time. Any additional expenses could cause us to discontinue the Annual Veterans Day Parade honoring these veterans who fought so hard for our freedom.

We feel it will serve a significant public purpose to waive these fees and honor the veterans who have served and our currently serving our great country.


