

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Candlelighters of El Paso has approached the El Paso County, Texas Commissioners Court with the desire to create a Cancer Survivors Park on the site of the former Landmark Building, which is currently owned by the County of El Paso; and

WHEREAS, the El Paso County Commissioners Court has expressed a desire to participate in the creation of such a park on the identified site; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a September 20, 2004 County Commissioners' Order, it is the intent of the El Paso County Commissioners Court to contribute the property for the park conditioned upon:

- 1) The City of El Paso's written agreement to accept title to the property for use as a public park and to operate and maintain the property as a public park in perpetuity, or
- 2) The City of El Paso's execution of an interlocal agreement to operate and maintain the property as a public park, with a provision for acceptance of liability for the park and its operation, for a period of 20 years, and written agreement with the Candlelighters of El Paso or the City of El Paso to build the park and construct park improvements without capital contribution from the County of El Paso, Texas, other than the real property within an identified period of time. And, that Candlelighters of El Paso or the City of El Paso, with the County of El Paso's permission, may seek grant funding for this purpose, and

WHEREAS, Candlelighters of El Paso desires the City of El Paso's consideration and commitment to the creation of a Cancer Survivors Park,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO THAT:

That the City Manager, subject to the appropriate land acquisition procedures, be authorized to enter negotiations with the County of El Paso for the conveyance or lease of the site of the former Landmark Building as a Cancer Survivors Park, and that the City Manager to enter into negotiations and an agreement with Candlelighters of El Paso that it will apply and secure sufficient funds to construct and maintain a Cancer Survivors Park if the City accepts the real property from the County of El Paso.
