AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 12 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), CHAPTER 12.88 (SCHEDULES), SECTION 12.88.030 SCHEDULE III (PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS) OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE, BY DELETING NUMBER 157, LEE STREET BETWEEN MAGOFFIN AVENUE AND OLIVE AVENUE, WEST SIDE ONLY; THE PENALTY BEING AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 12.84.010 (VIOLATION--PENALTY) OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

This ordinance is being amended at the request of the El Paso Water Utility. This portion of Lee is wide enough to allow parking on both sides of the street. Traffic Engineering is collaborating with El Paso Water Utilities on curb improvements around their central El Paso facility and request this ordinance be removed from the "no parking" schedule. The Engineering Traffic Division concurs with this request.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 12 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), CHAPTER 12.88 (SCHEDULES), SECTION 12.88.030 SCHEDULE III (PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS) OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE, BY DELETING NUMBER 157, LEE STREET BETWEEN MAGOFFIN AVENUE AND OLIVE AVENUE, WEST SIDE ONLY; THE PENALTY BEING AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 12.84.010 (VIOLATION--PENALTY) OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

1. That Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 12.88 (Schedules), Section 12.88.030 (Schedule III – Parking Prohibited At All Times On Certain Streets) of the El Paso City Code shall be and hereby is amended to delete the following street from the streets presently listed in Schedule III, Parking Prohibited At All Times On Certain Streets.

157. Lee Street between Magoffin Avenue and Olive Avenue, west side only.

2. Except as expressly herein amended, Title 12 (Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 12.88 (Schedules), Section 12.88.030 (Schedule III, Parking Prohibited At All Times On Certain Streets) of the El Paso City Code shall remain in full force and effect.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 20-179 SCHEDULE III (PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS) OF THE EL PASO CITY CODE, THE PENALTY BEING AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 20-26 OF THE CODE

That Section 20-179 of the El Paso City Code (Schedule III, parking prohibited at all times on certain streets) be and is hereby amended by adding the following new subparagraph:

Lee Street between Magoffin Avenue and Olive Avenue, west side only.

Ref: Angled Parking on Lee and Olive Street for El Paso Water Utilities

Dear Mr. Marquez:

El Paso Water Utilities (EPWU) hereby requests that the City of El Paso authorize angled parking along Lee and Olive Streets for EPWU operations and warehouse facilities located at 209, 210 and 221 N. Lee Street. The layout of the existing angled parking facilities is shown on the enclosures. Angled parking at these facilities was pre-existing at the time EPWU purchased these properties. However, an investigation by the City Streets Department during repaving operations revealed that the angled parking had not been authorized by the City.

More than 100 EPWU employees that depend on the existing angle parking and nearby parallel parking. Also, the traffic volumes at the parking areas are fairly low, as are the average vehicle speeds. It is my understanding, based on communications with one of the City's traffic inspectors, that there is not a history of accidents in the area. I would appreciate your assistance in obtaining the necessary City Council authorizations to allow this angle parking.
